Arts @ Large begins by creating project teams within schools – teams that include classroom teachers, administrators, art and music specialists. Teams establish school-wide arts integration goals targeting academic subjects in need of improvement. Then, Arts @ Large helps teams identify visual, literary and performing artists and arts organizations that are highly qualified to collaborate with teachers to provide arts experiences tailored to enhance targeted curriculum.

While students engage in vibrant art and literary experiences designed to build academic skills; classroom teachers, specialists and artist partners share techniques, adding tools to their “bag of tricks” that motivate students to learn. Teachers develop a deep appreciation of the learning power of the arts, while they work in

a collaborative model to plan and implement arts programming tailored to fit their own unique school environment.
