- Prepare and sell coffee drinks by following prescribed recipes and preparation techniques, as taught by Anodyne Coffee Roasters.
- Generate revenues by attracting new customers and providing excellent customer service.
- Work with the café team to create new and expanded menu offerings.
- Maintain inventory by stocking items as needed throughout shift and communicate inventory shortages to Café Manager.
- Keep equipment operating by following operating instructions, troubleshooting breakdowns, maintaining supplies, performing regular preventive maintenance, and calling for repairs as needed.
- Maintain a safe and healthy work environment by following organization standards and sanitation regulations.
- Maintain a spotless appearance of the food prep, coffee bar, and café areas.
- Participate in professional development and mandatory trainings
- Assist in all areas of café operations
- Take pride and ownership in work
- Perform any additional tasks and responsibilities as assigned

**Skills:** Active listening, verbal and written communication skills, youth leadership, customer focus, customer service, basic safety, people skills, action oriented, organization, good attendance, exemplify customer relations, time management.

### **Qualifications:**

- Previous barista experience preferred.
- Knowledge of food safety, sanitations, and food handling procedures. Food Handlers license preferred.

- Ability to stand and work for up to 8 hours.
- Ability to lift product and restock.

Baristas will regularly stand for long periods of time, bend, stoop, turn, lift, talk, walk, walk on uneven ground, and occasionally carry and lift up to fifty (50) pounds. Team lift is required for anything over twenty-five (25) pounds or any awkward lifting.
