Introduction

Welcome to www.artsatlargeinc.org (the "Site"). The Site is owned and operated by Arts @ Large and its affiliates ("We", "Us", "Our" or "A@L"). This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, store, and share information about you through this Site. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

This Privacy Policy applies only to information we collect at and through the Site. This Site contains links to third-party sites that are not owned or controlled by us, such as Google, Instagram, Facebook, and LinkedIn. Please be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices of such sites, and we encourage you to read the privacy statements of such third party websites prior to your use thereof.

What Information We Collect and Why We Collect It

You are not required to create an account or submit your personal information to us in order to use the Site. However, your personal information may be required to access features or areas, such as registering for an online account at the Site, registering for events, or subscribing to newsletters. The information we require for these features may include your name, home address, telephone number, and email address.

If you are under the age of 18, please do not attempt to register with us at this Site or provide any personal information about yourself to us. If we learn that we have collected personal information from a person under the age of 18, we will promptly delete that information. If you believe we may have collected personal information from someone under the age of 18, please email info@artsatlargeinc.org.

We collect non-personal information as you use our Site, such as your IP address, browser type, computer or mobile device type, unique device identifiers, operating system version, the website from where you navigated to our Site, time and date of using our Site, the name of your Internet service provider (ISP), and location/geo-location information.

When you visit our Site, we may send one or more “cookies” to your computer or other mobile device. A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. When you visit the website again, the cookie allows that site to recognize your browser. Cookies may store unique identifiers, user preferences, and other information. We use cookies to improve the quality of our service, including storing user preferences, tracking user trends, and providing relevant advertising to you. Please note that cookies don't allow us to gain control of your computer in any way. They are strictly used to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not, so that we can provide a better experience for you.

If you want to disable cookies, you can do it by accessing the settings of your internet browser. You can visit internetcookies.com, which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers and devices.

How We Use and Share Your Information

We collect information from you so that we can provide you with your requested services. For example, we use your personal information to contact you about programs you registered for, process credit card transactions, and send you information about an event you registered to attend.

In addition to the sharing described elsewhere in this Policy, we will share personal information with companies, organizations or individuals outside of A@L when we have your consent to do so. We require opt-in consent for the sharing of any sensitive personal information. Sensitive personal information is a particular category of personal information relating to confidential medical facts, racial or ethnic origins, political or religious beliefs, or sexuality.

Mobile Opt in, SMS Consent, and phone numbers collected for SMS communication purposes will not be shared with any third party or affiliates for marketing purposes.

Access to Your Information and Choices You Can Make

We also provide you the opportunity to opt-out of having your information used for certain purposes. For example, if you purchase a product/service but do not wish to receive any additional marketing materials from us, you can indicate your preference on our order form.

We may share personal information with certain third parties if we have a good-faith belief that such access, use, preservation or disclosure of the information is legally required or necessary to protect against harm to our rights, property or the safety of our users, customers, or the public, and to the extent as required or permitted by law.

If the ownership of our business changes or we transfer assets relating to our business to a third party, such as by merger, acquisition, bankruptcy proceeding or otherwise, we may need to transfer or sell your personal information to the new owner. In such a case, your information will remain subject to the promises made in the applicable privacy policy unless you expressly agree otherwise.

5. Security of Your Information

To help protect your personal information, access to it on our Site is password-protected, and sensitive data (such as your credit card number) is encrypted when it is exchanged between your web browser and our Site. We use industry-standard physical, technical, and administrative security measures to protect your personal information. However, since the Internet is not a 100% secure environment, we cannot guarantee, ensure, or warrant the security of any information that you transmit to us. It is your responsibility to protect the security of your login information. Please also note that e-mails and other communications you send to us through our Site are not encrypted, and we strongly advise you not to communicate any confidential information through these means.
